- Brain tumours are the leading cause of cancer death in children under the age of 20.
- There are over 120 different types of brain tumours, making treatment very complicated.
 - Brain tumours drastically affect physical and cognitive abilities and quality of life.

10 Facts About Brain Tumours

- Although as many as 60% of children with brain tumours will survive, they are often left with long-term side effects.
 - Metastatic brain tumours occur at some point in 20-40% of people with cancer.
 - The average patient will make 52 visits to their health care team in the first year of diagnosis.
 - In May 2019, the Brain Tumour Registry of Canada was launched. Accurate data will help researchers understand the disease and improve treatment.
 - An estimated 55,000 Canadians are living with a brain tumour.
