1. Every day, **27** Canadians are diagnosed with a brain tumour.
2. Brain tumours are the leading cause of cancer death in children under the age of **20**.
3. There are over **120** different types of brain tumours, making treatment very complicated.
4. Although as many as **60** % of children with brain tumours will survive, they are often left with long-term side effects.
5. Metastatic brain tumours occur at some point in 20 - **40** % of people with cancer.
6. The average patient will make **52** visits to their health care team in the first year.
7. In May **2019**, the Brain Tumour Registry of Canada was launched. Accurate data will help researchers understand the disease and improve treatment for those affected.
8. It is estimated that **55,000** Canadians are surviving with a brain tumour.
