- The abstract title must be in lower case letters except for the first word and abbreviations, and followed by the authors' initials, family name(s), city and province/country. Please place an asterisk by the name of the presenting author.
- An individual may present more than one abstract.
- Notification of acceptance and presentation schedule will be sent via email on or before March 31, 2023.

YOUNG INVESTIGATOR RESEARCH AWARDS:

Two "Young Investigator Awards", made possible by the Canadian Brain Tumour Consortium, will be awarded (selected by the CNO awards committee). Graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, residents in training and allied health professionals are eligible.

Young Investigator Award in Basic Science \$1,500 CND
Young Investigator Award in Clinical Investigation \$1,500 CND

Ten (10) travel grants of \$500 each will also be awarded (selected by the CNO awards committee) to help graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, residents in training, and allied health professionals travel to Ottawa to present their research.
