- Prepare your poster to fit on a 5' wide x 4' high poster board
- All posters should be set up before the welcome address at 8:55 am or during morning break (10:15-10:45 am) and presenters should be at their posters during the Poster session (1:00-3:00 pm); all posters must be taken down by 5:00 pm
- Push-pins will be provided to attach posters to the boards
- Posters will be numbered and locations will be provided upon arrival at the retreat
- Posters will be evaluated for peer poster prizes
