Instructions for Submission of Abstract:

- 1. Submit an electronic abstract (not exceeding 250 words) using 12-point typeface in Word format only by March 7, 2025
- 2. To submit an abstract via the website go to https://www.cnomeeting.ca/callforabstracts.cfm
- 3. The website does not support special characters, so these must be spelled out.

- 4. The abstract title must be in lower case letters except for the first word and abbreviations, and followed by the authors' initials, family name(s), city and province/country. Please place an asterisk by the name of the presenting author.
- 5. An individual may present more than one abstract.
- 6. Notification of acceptance and presentation schedule will be sent via email on or before March 31, 2025.

NOTE: As the deadline for early bird registration is January 31, 2025, if your abstract is accepted the early bird registration fee will apply. We will email an invoice reflecting that amount.

YOUNG INVESTIGATOR RESEARCH AWARDS
